Lancaster County Solid Waste Management Authority and PPL Renewable Energy to host tours of the Wind Project at Turkey Point

LANCASTER, Pa.—The Lancaster County Solid Waste Management Authority (LCSWMA) and PPL Renewable Energy will host tours of the Wind Project at Turkey Point on Saturday, September 17th.

Free two-hour tours will depart at 9:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m., and 2:30 p.m. Visitors of all ages are welcome. Seating is limited, so pre-registration is required. Delicious Turkey Hill ice cream and a small gift will be provided to all registered guests.

Parking and check-in will be at Creswell Park, located on River Road. Visitors should arrive 15 minutes before their scheduled tour time. This is a rain or shine event.

PPL Renewable Energy's 3.2-megawatt wind power project is located at the Frey Farm Landfill in Lancaster County, which is owned by LCSWMA. The power generated by the two, 1.6-megawatt wind turbines is purchased by the adjacent Turkey Hill Dairy, maker of high-quality ice cream, milk, and tea products. The Wind Project at Turkey Point generates about 25 percent of Turkey Hill Dairy's electricity needs—enough power to produce 6 million gallons of ice cream or power 700 homes each year.
