## WELCOME TO THE FAMILY SCAVENGER HUNT FOR THE FREY FARM LANDFILL VIRTUAL TOUR!

The "Find" challenges below connect you to an interesting fact in each Scene, while the "Explore" provides an activity you can do in your own home and neighborhood. FIND: Locate the age that Ulrich Rieber moved to Lancaster. He had quite the journey to America and, finally, Lancaster County.







Locate the title of the person who greets customers at the Scale House. This individual helps weigh customer loads and directs them to the proper location on site.

**EXPLORE:** Pick three items that are close in size. Weigh each one. Why do you think their weights differ?

**FIND**. Locate the backhoe loader in this scene. This piece of equipment helps move and lift heavy pieces of trash. SMALL VEHICLE **EXPLORE:** Visit bit.ly/3uq5VnN to learn how this piece of heavy equipment works. Locate the two systems that seal the landfill from the surrounding environment. These are key parts of our Environmental Controls. DISPOSAL AREA **EXPLORE:** Look under a sink in your house. How does it keep water or other liquids from spilling onto the floor? Can you imagine how the landfill works in a similar way? Locate the name of the material used to cover the waste at the TIPPING AREA end of each day. This helps control odor and litter at the landfill. **EXPLORE:** Watch "See the Tipping Area in Action" video in this scene to understand how heavy equipment operators compact the waste to reduce its size. Locate the number of tons of metal recycled each year at this facility. This material is recycled and turned into new products. **EXPLORE:** Find a magnet and see what types of material it will pick up. Locate the number of homes and businesses powered by the landfill gas plant. In Lancaster County, 1 in 5 area homes is powered by all LCSWMA's green-energy projects. **EXPLORE:** Visit bit.ly/3HKPLsX and learn more about how much energy your home uses. Locate the number of ice cream gallons made from the two wind turbines each year. Could you eat that much ice cream in your life? EXPLORE: Create your own wind turbine at home:
