Why is LCSWMA imposing a \$20 penalty for open loads that are not secured by a tarp?

1. It protects the HEALTH and SAFETY of our community

Unsecured loads and debris in the road led to 200,000 crashes between 2011-2014

2. It Protects the ENVIRONMENT

As a nation, we spend \$11.5 billion a year combating litter, 40% of which comes from unsecured loads

3. It's the LAW

Pennsylvania's state and federal requirements are as follows: Loads must be covered with a securely fastened water-resistant cover that eliminates potential for littering and other nuisances. 25 Pa. Code §§ 285.211(a) and 299.211(a)

Please secure your open load! It prevents litter and saves lives.
