#### 1. BOARD ACTION NO. 1: APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 15, 2023

Chairperson Rettew asked for any additions or corrections to the meeting minutes. Being none, a motion was requested to approve the Minutes of September 15, 2023, as distributed.

#### **Chief Executive Officer**

Mr. Zorbaugh opened with an update on the Zoning Text Amendment submitted to Manor Township Supervisors, in which the amendment was viewed favorably and passed on to the Manor Township Planning Commission, and will be sent to with the Lancaster County Planning Commission for comment. The process continues and Mr. Zorbaugh said he will communicate updates.

Next, Mr. Zorbaugh touched on legislative action by the Pennsylvania Municipal Authorities Association (PMAA) House Bill 1607, a PA DEP recycling act focusing on covered devices. The current program places a burden on communities to collect and dispose of these devices. Mr. Zorbaugh provided highlights from the bill, e.g., including placing greater responsibility on producers and having the oversight of an advisory committee, in the hopes of improving the system.

Mr. Zorbaugh moved on to a performance review, including sound financials exceeding budget expectations, the significant progress on all capital projects, including the FFLF VE construction, successes with all environmental performance, and mention of the fall outage schedule at WTE, including the first installation of the new Low NOx technology.

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Mr. Zorbaugh noted the new trailer wrap reflecting LCSWMA's battery recycling campaign and he recognized the efforts of Karen Gross, Communications Manager, as well as the Battery Committee for their diligence with this marketing strategy.

In conclusion, Mr. Zorbaugh introduced and discussed the Consent Agenda items for board consideration, including the September 2023 Disbursements and a lease extension with T-Mobile with details as distributed.

### **Chief Financial Officer**

Mr. Youngs touched on the highlights of his report to the board, as distributed.

In addition, Mr. Youngs recognized Cale Fetterolf for seamlessly managing a technological shift into a data warehouse

### **Chief Operating Officer**

Mr. Adams provided details on the waste business outlook, including a focus on year-to-date numbers vs. budget and the macroeconomic effects, impacted by high inflation on the tonnage decrease.

Lastly, Mr. Adams fielded questions from the Board before introducing two action items for Board consideration and approval. In addition, Mr. Henderson, General Counsel, provided background into the sales tax complexities involving municipal authority status exceptions around what is taxable vs. exempt. A copy of the board actions are attached.

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### **Chief Business & Compliance Officer**

Ms. Marsh began with details from her board report as submitted, including various updates on energy revenues and headwinds.

Ms. Marsh concluded by providing details on recordable safety incidents year-to-date and noted that the former Safety Committee had evolved into the Environmental, Health & Safety (EHS) Committee, including participants (Site Champions) from every site. Also, Ms. Marsh noted the soft launch of a new Learning Management System (LMS) to aid with employee training. She recognized Cris Altman, Safety Manager, Nicole Roy, Risk Analyst, Mike Devaney, Waste Division Director, and Amanda Manning, Human Resources Manager for their diligence and collaboration on safety and risk initiatives.

#### **Budget Presentation**

The proposed 2024 Operating and Capital Budget summary was presented to the Board by the Executive Team, including overall philosophy highlights, a breakout on 2024 waste volumes, rates, revenues and expenses, and a summary of capital expenditures.

In addition, the Executive Team provided a 5-year plan and long-term financial outlook.

### SECOND AMENDMENT TO SITE LICENSE AGREEMENT

This Second Amendment to Site License Agreement (the "<u>Second Amendment</u>") is effective as of the last signature below (the "<u>Effective Date</u>"), by and between Lancaster County Solid Waste Management Authority ("<u>Licensor</u>" or "<u>LCSWMA</u>"), and T-Mobile Northeast LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("<u>Licensee</u>") (each a "<u>Party</u>", or collectively, the "<u>Parties</u>").

Licensor and Licensee or their predecessors-in-interest entered into that certain Site License Agreement dated October 12, 1999, as amended by First Amendment to Site License Agreement dated February 2, 2000 (the "<u>Agreement</u>") regarding the licensed premises ("<u>Premises</u>") located at 1911 River Road, Bainbridge, PA 17502 (the "<u>Property</u>").

For good and valuable consideration, Licensor and Licensee agree as follows:

- 1. The Agreement is in full force and effect and neither Licensor nor Licensee is in breach under the terms of the Agreement.
- 2. At the expiration of the Agreement, the term of the Agreement will automatically be extended for six (6) additional and successive five (5) year terms, each included as a Renewal Term, provided that Licensee may elect not to renew by providing Licensor at least thirty (30) days' notice prior to the expiration of the then current Renewal Term.
- 3. At the commencement of the first Renewal Term provided for in this Second Amendment, Licensee shall pay Licensor One Thousand Four Hundred Forty and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,440.00) per month as Fees, partial calendar months to be prorated in advance, by the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) day of each calendar month. Thereafter, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Agreement, the Fees will continue to escalate by 12.5% on the first day of each Renewal Term. Where duplicate Fees would occur, a credit shall be taken by Licensee for any prepayment of duplicate Fees by Licensee.
- 4. All notices, requests, demands and other communications shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been delivered upon receipt or refusal to accept delivery, and are effective only when deposited into the U.S. certified mail, return receipt requested, or when sent via a nationally recognized courier to the addresses set forth below. Licensor or Licensee may from time to time designate any other address for this purpose by providing written notice to the other Party.

- 5. Licensee and Licensor will reasonably cooperate with each other's requests to approve permit applications and other documents related to the Property without additional payment or consideration.
- 6. Licensor will execute a Memorandum of Agreement at Licensee's request. If the Property is encumbered by a deed, mortgage or other security interest, Licensor will also execute a subordination, non-disturbance and attornment agreement.
- 7. Any charges payable under the Agreement other than Fees shall be billed by Licensor to Licensee within twelve (12) months from the date in which the charges were incurred or due; otherwise, the same shall be deemed time-barred and be forever waived and released by Licensor.
- 8. Except as expressly set forth in this Second Amendment, the Agreement otherwise is unmodified. To the extent any provision contained in this Second Amendment conflicts with the terms of the Agreement, the terms and provisions of this Second Amendment shall control. Each reference in the Agreement to itself shall be deemed also to refer to this Second Amendment.
- 9. This Second Amendment may be executed in duplicate counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original. Signed electronic, scanned, or facsimile copies of this Second Amendment will legally bind the Parties to the same extent as originals.
- 10. Each of the Parties represents and warrants that it has the right, power, legal capacity and authority to enter into and perform its respective obligations under this Second Amendment. Licensor represents and warrants to Licensee that the consent or approval of a third party has either been obtained or is not required with respect to the execution of Second Amendment. If Licensor is represented by any property manager, broker or any other leasing agent ("Agent"), then (a) Licensor is solely responsible for all commission, fees or other payment to Agent and (b) Licensor shall not impose any fees on Licensee to compensate or reimburse Licensor for the use of Agent, including any such commissions, fees or other payments arising from negotiating or entering into this Second Amendment or any future amendment.
- 11. This Second Amendment will be binding on and inure to the benefit of the Parties herein, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors-in-interest and assigns.

### **Board Action No. 3**

**ISSUE:** Change Order No. 1 to Kinsley Construction, Inc. for the Frey Farm Landfill (FFLF) Maintenance Building Construction Project (General Construction)

**BACKGROUND:** A contract was awarded at the March 17, 2023, Board of Directors meeting to Kinsley Construction, Inc. for the Frey Farm Landfill (FFLF) Maintenance Building Construction Project (General Construction). The existing maintenance building will be demolished to allow for the construction of Stage 3 of the Frey Farm Landfill Vertical Expansion. The new maintenance building will be 17,000 square feet and incorporate two vehicle maintenance bays, a wash bay, parts and equipment storage, and an office area. The original contract price was \$4,146,969.00.

**DISCUSSION:** Change Order No. 1 will increase Kinsley's current contract amount to include sales tax on certain components of the work.

## **Board Action No. 4**

**ISSUE:** Frey Farm Landfill Vertical Expansion (FFVE) Stage 3 Construction Quality Assurance (CQA) Testing and Inspection Services

**BACKGROUND:** The FFVE Stage 3 project will increase the capacity of the Frey Farm Landfill with the construction of approximately 1,800 linear feet of mechanically stabilized earthen (MSE) berm and 2.8 acres of additional liner. The project will also include the installation of 12.5 acres of final cap system in Stage 1 and numerous leachate and landfill gas system modifications. The project is expected to take two years, with completion in October 2025. The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection requires landfill construction projects to have engineering oversight, inspection, and testing to ensure they are constructed in accordance with regulatory requirements. An experienced third-party engineering and consulting firm will be utilized for these services due to the size and complexity of the project.

**DISCUSSION:** Staff worked with our existing landfill consultant, ARM Group of Hershey, to develop a scope for CQA services required for the FFVE Stage 3 Construction Project. ARM Group provided a proposal for the services with an estimated cost of \$839,620. ARM Group has completed all of the engineering, design, and permitting associated with the FFVE and is intimately familiar with the project. Staff feels ARM Group's knowledge of landfill design and construction, as well as their past experience with the Frey Farm Landfill and excellent working relationship with PADEP, make them uniquely qualified to complete these services.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends the Board of Directors award the Construction Quality Assurance Testing and Inspection Services for the FFVE Stage 3 to ARM Group of Hershey, PA in the estimated amount of \$839,620.
