

### **Board of Directors | Meeting Minutes**

DATE: February 16, 2024

TIME: 7:30 a.m.

#### **Attendance**

#### **Opening**

In Chairperson Rettew's absence, Vice Chairperson Blowers called the meeting to order and welcomed Jacquelin Eby as the newest member of the Board of Directors before requesting a moment of silence followed by the pledge to the flag.

#### **Public Comment**

Mr. Morris introduced himself and addressed the Board with comments and questions regarding LCSWMA's Variable Compensation Guidance, compensation paid to the Executive Team, and publications regarding staff compensation. A copy of the transcript read by Mr. Morris is attached.

#### **Chief Executive Officer**

Mr. Zorbaugh opened with a recap of recent activities, including a detailed debrief of the EPA virtual public meeting held on February 7<sup>th</sup> regarding the EPA proposed regulations for large municipal waste combustors Maximum Achievable Control Technologies (MACT) in which he and staff participated. Mr. Zorbaugh stressed various points, including supporting WTE as opposed to landfilling, as well as calling out the EPA's failure to review criteria in their own proposed regulatory policy for a residual risk analysis.

Next, Mr. Zorbaugh gave a general summary of the Executive Team board reports and emphasized a very positive start to the first quarter, as well as a brief update on capital projects at the FFLF.

Mr. Zorbaugh concluded his report by providing a summary of the items for Board action in the Consent Agenda. Copies of the Board actions are attached.

#### **Chief Financial Officer**

Mr. Youngs began by providing highlights of LCSWMA's financials for the month of January, with tonnage exceeding budget, despite two snow events. Mr. Youngs continued reporting above budget details in operating revenues, as well as other long-term financial projects and investments.

Next, Mr. Youngs highlighted recognitions to several departments, including Emily Patzer, Claire Paton, Aaron Cutarelli, and Cathy Sultzbaugh for their efforts with providing support to the field work conducted by the auditors. In addition, Mr. Youngs recognized Nick Kohr and the engineering team's work on capital projects, including the fire suppression installation project. Additionally, Mr. Youngs recognized Nicole Roy's work leading the effort on the upcoming launch of the new Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) system, including data tracking, and insurance claims management, as well as giving thanks to Ms. Marsh for her efforts moving various safety initiatives forward in the absence of a safety coordinator.

Finally, Mr. Youngs presented details on three action items for Board consideration. Copies of the Board actions are attached.

#### **Chief Operating Officer**

Mr. Adams began with remarks on exceeding budget, despite the impact of weather events and a shoutout to the Operations team's success with coordination efforts. Mr. Adams also provided further information on the truck purchase and philosophy of maintaining a 60/40 ratio of CNG/diesel vehicles in order to take advantage of the incentivized \$10,000.00 per truck grant funding opportunity.

Vice Chairperson Blowers and Ms. Weibel offered kudos to the engineering team on the success with the short list of projects. Mr. Adams recognized Nick Kohr, Rob Burke, and John Snyder for their diligence.

In conclusion, Mr. Adams fielded questions from the Board regarding maintenance of CNG vs. diesel vehicles, the status of capital projects, including the new FFLF maintenance building construction and



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recognizing Kinsley Company as a great partner. In addition, Mr. Adams provided updates on the NOx system installation which concluded with successful results from the testing period.

#### **Chief Business & Compliance Officer**

Before introducing the Yearly Energy Governance & Risk Review focus topic, Ms. Marsh touched on a positive start to the year with both energy and compliance. Energy revenues exceeded budget, and forward hedging was very successful. Ms. Marsh deferred details to the forthcoming focus topic presentation.

Ms. Marsh continued with an update on the EPA's newly released standards for MACT regulations for large municipal waste combustors, including a presentation on the nine pollutant categories that MACT regulates, showing the 5-year average for SRMC and Lancaster WTE against the existing and newly proposed standards. Further, Ms. Marsh reiterated the importance of the EPA's failure to perform the risk analysis that is compliant with the Clean Air Act (CAA). Ms. Marsh explained that public comment will be heard until March 25<sup>th</sup> and LCSWMA is drafting a letter of comment to submit.

Ms. Weibel and the Board thanked Covanta for their partnership. In addition, Ms. Weibel commended Karen Gross and Kelly Morris for their diligence regarding the safe battery disposal campaign.

Ms. Marsh fielded questions from the Board and presented details on an action item for Board consideration. Copies of the Board actions are attached.

4. BOARD ACTION NO. 5: MOTION TO APPROVE THE AWARD OF THE ONE-YEAR CONTRACT FOR HHW SERVICES TO ACV ENVIRO FOR A TOTAL ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$309,724.05.

Mr. Henderson, General Counsel, stated that an Executive Session would be held to discuss a Real Estate matter, but no actions will be taken during or after the Executive Session.

#### **Board Action No. 1 (3)**

**ISSUE:** Purchase of Equipment for 2024 Delivery

**BACKGROUND:** LCSWMA utilizes a cyclical equipment replacement schedule, with replacement frequency based on utilization rate, maintenance costs, and residual value of each type of equipment. Staff presented the 2024 fiscal year budget and capital expenditures plan (including equipment) at the October Board of Directors' meeting, with Board action on the budget at the November meeting.

**DISCUSSION:** LCSWMA uses cooperative bidding and purchasing contracts when available to procure new equipment to minimize cost. The chart below details the site, type and model, cost, estimated trade-in or auction value, net cost, 2024 budget amount, variance to this amount, and purchasing contract for each piece of equipment. This is the second of several batch purchases of equipment for 2024.

# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING BINDING CERTAIN CASUALTY INSURANCE CONTRACTS BETWEEN RAFFLES INSURANCE, LTD. AND LANCASTER COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Lancaster County Solid Waste Management Authority ("LCSWMA" or "the Authority") utilizes a captive insurance structure, Raffles Insurance, LTD. ("Raffles"), owned by the collective body of insured entities and managed by Captive Resources LLC, for the procurement of General Liability, Business Automobile, and Workers' Compensation insurances ("Insurances"). Zurich American Insurance Company ("Zurich") is the fronting carrier.

WHEREAS, the Authority's current General Liability, Business Automobile, and Workers' Compensation insurance policies, with collectively \$287,497 in premium, expire March 31, 2024 ("Expiring Policies");

WHEREAS, the Authority currently has in force the following Expiring Policies: (1) a General Liability policy written by Zurich with a \$2 million limit (premium cost \$120,786); (2) a Business Automobile policy written by Zurich with a \$2 million limit (premium cost \$99,736); and (3) a \$1 million Workers' Compensation policy written by Zurich (premium cost \$66,975);

WHEREAS, the Authority provided a renewal submission including required information, including but not limited to, estimated plan-year operating revenues, estimated plan-year salaries and wages, and quantities of covered vehicles.

WHEREAS, the Authority's 2024 approved budget incorporates an aggregate premium increase of 10% for renewing the Expiring Policies.

WHEREAS, the Authority received pricing on February 15, 2024 for renewing the Expiring Policies at an aggregate premium cost of \$296,862 (+3.3% increase).

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that on or before April 1, 2024, the Authority shall bind coverage for the Insurances written through the Raffles Insurance, LTD. insurance captive with coverages substantially equal to, or better than, the Expiring Policies, as determined by the Chief Executive Officer ("CEO") of the Authority and collective annual premium of \$296,862 for the plan year beginning April 1, 2024; and

**FURTHER RESOLVED,** by the Board of the Authority, that Robert B. Zorbaugh, LCSWMA's CEO, acting alone, hereby is authorized and directed to take all actions, and to execute and deliver all documents, in the name and on behalf of the Authority, and under its corporate seal or otherwise, and to pay all such expenses, which shall in his judgment be necessary, proper or advisable in order to fully carry out the intent of, and to fully effectuate, the foregoing resolution.

#### **Board Action No. 3**

**ISSUE:** Replacement of LCSWMA's internal server equipment as part of the ongoing technology equipment refresh cycle.

**BACKGROUND:** LCSWMA replaces information system hardware on a 5-year schedule that is extended as appropriate. Systems are replaced to ensure reliability and performance while also maintaining supportability from the manufacturers.

**DISCUSSION:** In 2024, Information Technology (IT) is making a significant shift to utilizing cloud services and reducing the dependence on internal and on-premises resources. As several servers reached the end of useful life, and in review of the remaining non-cloud infrastructure requirements, the IT team identified a server refresh plan that is significantly less in scope than prior iterations of server replacements. The hardware quoted includes a five-year maintenance and support arrangement as well as three-year Microsoft licensing and five-year infrastructure management services.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Computer, Design and Integration, LLC (CDI), has provided a quote for the required equipment and services. CDI is a Costars approved vendor. The quoted cost of the equipment is \$95,031.34 and the multi-year software licensing and services is \$46,755.20 for a combined quote of \$141,786.54. \$225,000 was budgeted in 2024 for this project.

#### **Board Action No. 4**

ISSUE: Frey Farm Landfill (FFLF) Site Access Control and Camera Replacement

#### **BACKGROUND:**

LCSWMA facilities are equipped with various technology inclusive of site security and on-premise camera surveillance to monitor site safety, security and operations. Camera surveillance provides managers with the ability to monitor site operations and traffic flow. These systems prove valuable during times of debate on claims and incidents while also providing means for coaching employees on best practices for safety and equipment operation. The FFLF facility utilizes numerous cameras with video storage and playback functionality as well as site security systems to monitor and limit access to the site.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Staff obtained pricing through the PA COSTARS purchasing program. Triangle Communications, a reputable Lancaster County organization, provided a quote using the Avigilon camera system and a comprehensive access control system utilizing Access IT software. Avigilon systems are used at all other LCSWMA sites. This project is necessary because (1) the existing camera system is at the end of its useful life and (2) there is equipment needed to outfit the new maintenance and administrative building at the FFLF. The site access control and camera replacement was budgeted in 2024 at \$90,000.

#### **Board Action No. 5**

ISSUE: Award of Contract for Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Services

**BACKGROUND:** Lancaster County residents may deliver to LCSWMA's HHW Facility, free of charge, household hazardous waste and electronic waste. Approximately 41,000 residents deliver materials to the HHW facility, with over 1,600 tons of material received each year. The household hazardous waste portion of this material is consolidated, packaged, and transported from the site for processing by a vendor. The current contract for these services with ACV Enviro, Republic Services, expires on February 29, 2024.

**DISCUSSION:** In December, LCSWMA staff released a request for proposal (RFP) for household hazardous waste services to include packaging, transportation, and treatment/recycling/disposal of materials received at the HHW Facility for a one-year term. LCSWMA received proposals from two qualified vendors. A summary of the cost from each vendor is listed below, which is based on the annual estimated waste quantities listed in the RFP.
